

# Hawera High School Stationery / School Costs List 2020 Year 9

Students are requested to purchase their stationery during the summer break and to be prepared for the beginning of the school year, although on the first day of school (Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020) Year 9 students will only need to bring a lined refill or exercise book and a pen.

#### All Year 9 students take the following subjects:

#### **Core Subjects**

English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, or Te Wera Programme plus Te Reo Maori & Hauora (Health & PE)

#### **Rotations**

Construction Technology, Digital Technology, Food Technology, Textiles Technology, Art, Performing Arts (1/3 of year each)

If you are not sure whether your student is doing separate English, Math, Science, Social Studies or the Te Wera Programme please contact the school office.

Please check the stationery requirements for each subject and option.

It is expected that students will also have general stationery such as pens, rulers etc.

(These items are listed as ALL STUDENTS on the stationery list)

Please find following a list of school take home component costs; **Invoices for these costs will** be posted home as soon as all class placements have been confirmed. Payment is to be made to the office.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. A **school diary** containing useful school information will be issued free of charge. It is used as a homework notebook and as a means of communicating with parents. It is also a very useful self-management tool.
- 2. All students will be provided with an **ID card**. The student's library number is on this card. It is also useful for other purposes outside school as it has the student's photo and birth date on it.
- 3. All take home component costs need to be paid (on invoice) to ensure that the materials are available; they are an essential part of the course. It is important if a student is taking the subject that they pay these costs.
- 4. Eftpos is available at the office. You can also pay by Direct Credit to our bank account. Instructions for this are printed on the invoices.

### HAWERA HIGH SCHOOL FAMILY ACCOUNTS

This is a service the school offers to families. In order to take advantage of this service the school requires families to commit to regular payments (via automatic payment) to the Family Account during their students' time at Hawera High School.

Family Accounts allow for materials to be handed out and for activities to be undertaken before all subject costs are paid. Costs are processed once evidence of regular payment is observed, and the balance owing is transferred to the Family Account, which is then paid off by automatic payment.

Please note that payments need to be sufficient for the balance to be cleared by the end of each school year. If your Family Account is in credit, this will automatically transfer to the following year. The benefits of setting up a Family Account are:

- Students are not penalised for not having paid material costs
- School trips, sports subscriptions etc can be paid for using the Family Account
- Parents can indicate to add charges to their Family Account via permission slips, phoning the school office or sending a note with your student
- Account balances are issued monthly so parents have a regular record of charges and payments made to the Family Account
- One account per family with more than one child at school so if a child leaves the account remains active for children still at school
